Basic Information

Buena Regional High School is proud to offer 13 dual credit courses for the 2017-2018 school year. The attraction to the program is that students can receive college credits, at a much discounted price, without having to take an exam. We cannot guarantee that all colleges will accept these credits, but have found that most state schools and some private schools do accept the credits. Please see below for all of the specifics of our dual credit courses.

Dual Credit Courses at A.C.C.C.

The following courses have been approved for Dual Credit at ACCC:

- -French III
- -French IV
- -Spanish III
- -Spanish IV
- -Financial Accounting (Articulation)

Articulation Courses at A.C.C.C.:

- -The student <u>does not have to pay any money</u> for these courses. They just need to be enrolled and maintain an 85% average.
- -After graduating from Buena Regional High School, the student must attend A.C.C.C within 3 years and matriculate into one of the following articulation programs: Business Administration, Computer Information System, Hospitality Management, or Health Services.
- -The student will request a transfer evaluation form from Atlantic Cape's Admissions Office and pay the evaluation fee (\$25).
- -The student will provide to Atlantic Cape the **Student Application for Credit by Articulation** form signed by a high school official. This form can be found in the BRHS Guidance office.
- -The semester before the student graduates, A.C.C.C. will review the transcript of the student.
- -The transfer credit(s) for the following articulated courses will be valid only upon graduation from Atlantic Cape.
- -A.C.C.C. has an agreement with Stockton College that they accept all articulation credits, if the student receives an Associate's Degree from A.C.C.C.

Specifics of Dual Credit Process at A.C.C.C.

- 1. Student submits Application to ACCC (by Dec 1)
- 2. The Admission of ACCC sends Registration Forms to the school representative.
- 3. The school representative gives the registration forms to the students.
- 4. Student fill out the registration form and submits their registration payment of \$150 to the school representative.
- 5. The school representative mails the registration form and payment to the admissions office of ACCC. (by Apr 1)

Dual Credit Courses at RCBC

The following courses have been approved for the 2017-2018 school year:

- -AP Biology
- -AP Chemistry
- -AP Calculus
- -AP European History
- -AP US History I
- -AP US History II
- -AP English Language
- -AP English Literature
- -Honors Anatomy & Physiology

AP Courses

Students enrolled in an AP Course must maintain a "C" average in the course to receive dual credit. Students do not need to take the AP Test to receive dual credit.

Specifics of Dual Credits with RCBC

- Fees are \$150 and have been the same since the CAP Program began at BRHS. This fee is due no later than November 1 and should be made out to "Rowan College of Burlington College" as check or money order.
- 2. **RCBC will not alter registration deadlines** and the registration application must be received on time.
- 3. There will be **NO REFUNDS** once a student completes registration for a CAP class.
- 4. Student must receive a Final Grade of no less than a "C" to obtain credit from RCBC.
- 5. CAP is FREE for students/guardians of RCBC employees.
- 6. The Guidance Counselor must sign the application also.
- 7. Social Security Number is required on the application.
